NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

March 3, 2026

**GAME ON FENWAY LLC D/B/A GAME ON SPORTS CAFE

After a hearing on January 28, 2025, the Commission finds Game On Fenway, LLC d/b/a Game on Sports Café violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138, § 34C – Possession of an alcoholic beverage by a person under 21 years of age (17 Counts).

The Commission **suspends the license for a period of 15 days of which five (5) days will be served and 10 days will be held in abeyance for two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.**

The suspension shall commence on Monday, April 20, 2026, and terminate on Friday, April 24, 2026. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Monday, April 20, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee on April 25, 2026.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 § 23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

DECISION

**GAME ON FENWAY LLC D/B/A GAME ON SPORTS CAFE
72-82 LANSDOWNE STREET
BOSTON, MA 02215

HEARD: 01/28/2025**

Game On Fenway, LLC d/b/a Game on Sports Café (the “Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“ABCC” or “Commission”) held a hearing on Tuesday, January 28, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138, § 34C – Possession of an alcoholic beverage by a person under 21 years of age (17 Counts). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Gardner’s report.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On Friday, October 4, 2024, Investigators Teehan, Temple, Gardner, Gould, Smiddy and Terasconi (“Investigators”) inspected the business operations of Game On Fenway, LLC d/b/a Game On Sports Café (“Licensee” or “Game On”).
2. At approximately 10:30 p.m. Investigators entered the licensed premises and observed multiple youthful appearing individuals throughout the licensed premises in possession of what appeared to be alcoholic beverages.

3. Investigators Teehan and Temple approached a youthful appearing individual, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to possess alcoholic beverages.
4. Underage #1, actual date of birth 2/10/2005 (age 19), was in possession of a vodka and Red Bull mixed drink. She presented Investigators with a fraudulent Washington identification.
5. Investigators Gould, Gardner and Terasconi approached several youthful appearing individuals, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to possess alcoholic beverages.
6. Underage #2, actual date of birth 4/5/2004 (age 20), was in possession of a vodka cranberry mixed drink. She stated to Investigators that she was not asked for any identification at the door.
7. Underage #3, actual date of birth 8/1/2004 (age 20), was in possession of a vodka cranberry mixed drink. She stated to Investigators that she was not asked for any identification at the door.
8. Underage #4, actual date of birth 6/21/2005 (age 19), was in possession of a vodka and Red Bull mixed drink. She stated to Investigators that she did not present any identification to enter the establishment but paid \$20.00 to the bouncer at the door to gain entry to the licensed premises. She provided Investigators with a fraudulent Rhode Island driver's license bearing her name but a different birth date.
9. Underage #5, actual date of birth 11/11/2004 (age 19), was in possession of a Captain Morgan's Spiced rum and Coke mixed drink. He presented to Investigators a fraudulent Rhode Island driver's license bearing another person's name and birth date.
10. Underage #6, actual date of birth 3/11/2005 (age 19), was in possession of a tequila pineapple mixed drink. He stated that he did not present any identification at the door but paid \$20.00 to the bouncer to gain entry to the premises.
11. Underage #7, actual date of birth 1/7/2004 (age 20), was in possession of a Sun Cruiser. He stated that he did not present any identification at the door but paid \$20.00 to the bouncer to gain entry to the premises.
12. Investigators Gould and Terasconi approached some youthful appearing individuals, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to possess alcoholic beverages.
13. Underage #8, actual date of birth 8/9/2004 (age 20), was in possession of a Corona beer. He stated that he did not present any identification at the door but paid \$20.00 to the bouncer to gain entry to the premises.
14. Underage #9, actual date of birth 7/19/2005 (age 19), was in possession of a Jack Daniels whiskey and Coke mixed drink. He provided to Investigators a fraudulent Connecticut driver's license bearing his name but a different birth date.
15. Investigators Teehan and Smiddy approached some youthful appearing individuals, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to possess alcoholic beverages.

16. Underage #10, actual date of birth 11/9/2005 (age 18), was in possession of a Coors Light beer. He provided to Investigators a fraudulent Pennsylvania driver's license bearing his name but a different birth date.
17. Underage #11, actual date of birth 6/22/2006 (age 18), was in possession of a Coors Light beer. He provided to Investigators a fraudulent Pennsylvania driver's license bearing his name but a different birth date.
18. Investigators Temple and Smiddy approached a couple of youthful appearing individuals, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to possess alcoholic beverages.
19. Underage #12, actual date of birth 2/8/2005 (age 19), was in possession of a High Noon Pineapple. She provided Investigators with a fraudulent Connecticut driver's license bearing her name but a different birth date.
20. Underage #13, actual date of birth 7/28/2005 (age 19), was in possession of a High Noon Pineapple. She provided to Investigators a fraudulent Connecticut driver's license bearing her name but a different date of birth.
21. Underage #14, actual date of birth 9/22/2004 (age 20), was in possession of a vodka soda mixed drink. She provided Investigators with a fraudulent California driver's license bearing her name but a different birth date.
22. Underage #15, actual date of birth 10/3/2004 (age 20), was in possession of a vodka soda mixed drink. She provided Investigators with a fraudulent Connecticut driver's license bearing her name but a different birth date.
23. Underage #16, actual date of birth 4/15/2005 (age 19), was in possession of a Michelob Ultra beer. He stated that he did not present any identification at the door but paid \$20.00 to the bouncer to gain entry to the premises.
24. Underage #17, actual date of birth 12/30/2004 (age 20), was in possession of a Michelob Ultra beer. He provided to Investigators a fraudulent Connecticut driver's license bearing his name but a different birth date.
25. Investigators exited the premises and observed a female individual and male individual who appeared to be scanning tickets on people's phones. When asked who was checking identifications, they pointed to two doormen further down the line.
26. Investigators Teehan and Temple informed the manager on duty, Natalie Daining, that several underage individuals inside the premises stated they could pay bouncers at the door to enter. Investigators informed Ms. Daining of the violations and that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further review.
27. Ms. Daining appeared at the Commission hearing and testified that an identification scanner is located at the host station just inside the entrance to the licensed premises and was being used that evening.
28. Gerald Culbert, General Manager, appeared at the Commission hearing and testified the Licensee had no knowledge employees had been taking money in exchange for entrance

into the premises, and informed the Commission those employees were immediately terminated. Mr. Culbert also testified as to the Licensee's efforts to prevent future violations including installing more surveillance cameras at entry points, holding nightly security meetings and providing additional training for door staff. Vincent Lombardi, Senior Vice President of Operations for the Lyons Group, also appeared at the Commission hearing.


29. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138 § 12 since 2008.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138, § 34C – Possession of an alcoholic beverage by a person under 21 years of age (17 Counts). Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for a period of 15 days of which five (5) days will be served and 10 days will be held in abeyance for two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.**


