NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

May 27, 2016

After a hearing on May 24, 2016, the Commission finds Henry Quik Pik Inc. d/b/a Henry's Market violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (6 Counts).

The Commission **suspends the license for a period of thirty (30) days of which fifteen (15) days will be served, and fifteen (15) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**

The suspension shall commence on Wednesday, July 20, 2016 and terminate on Wednesday, August 3, 2016. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, July 20, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Thursday, August 4, 2016.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

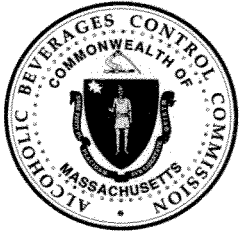
You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

DECISION

HENRY QUIK PIK INC. D/B/A HENRY'S MARKET

Henry Quik Pik Inc. d/b/a Henry's Market (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 24, 2016, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (6 Counts). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Teehan's report.

Which occurred at 5:35 PM, 5:50 PM, 6:45 PM, 7:45 PM, and 8:15

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Teehan's Investigative Report dated November 25, 2015;
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
3. Photocopy of Confiscated Fraudulent Licenses; and
4. RMV Printouts for 6 Minors.

A. Licensee's Copy of Fraudulent License which she confiscated on the day of the incident.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS


1. On Wednesday, November 25, 2015, Investigators Velez and Teehan ("Investigators") investigated the business operation of Henry Quik Pik Inc. d/b/a Henry's Market to determine the manner in which their business was being conducted.
2. Investigators conducted surveillance outside the licensed premises. At approximately 5:35 p.m. Investigators observed a youthful looking male subject exit the store with a 12-pack of Budweiser Light beer and a 6-pack of Twisted Tea malt beverage.
3. Investigators approached the male subject, identified themselves, and asked him for identification.
4. Underage #1 admitted his actual date of birth was 10/12/1997 (age 18). Underage #1 stated he used a fake South Carolina driver's license to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
5. While outside the premises at approximately 5:50 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful looking male subject exit the store with a 30-pack of Budweiser Light beer and a 6-pack of Mike's Hard Lemonade malt beverage.
6. Underage #2 had an actual date of birth of 10/27/1998 (age 17). He stated that he used a fake Rhode Island driver's license to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
7. While outside the premises at approximately 6:45 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful looking male subject exit the store with a 6-pack of Budweiser Light beer and a 6-pack of Angry Orchard hard cider.
8. Underage #3 had an actual date of birth of 01/23/1997 (age 18). He stated that he used a fake Rhode Island driver's license to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
9. While outside the premises at approximately 7:45 p.m., Investigators observed two youthful looking male subjects exit the store with a 30-pack of Budweiser Light beer and a 6-pack of Twisted Tea malt beverage.
10. Underage #4 had an actual date of birth of 08/19/1997 (age 18). He stated that he used a fake Rhode Island driver's license to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
11. Underage #5 had an actual date of birth of 01/23/1997 (age 18). He stated that he used a fake Rhode Island driver's license to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
12. While outside the premises at approximately 8:15 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful looking male subject exit the store with a 12-pack of Corona Extra beer and two 6-packs of Angry Orchard hard cider.
13. Underage #6 had an actual date of birth of 06/27/1996 (age 19).
14. Investigators entered the store and informed the clerk on duty, Dipish Dahal, of the violations and that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further review.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (6 Counts). Therefore the Commission **suspends the license for a period of thirty (30) days of which fifteen (15) days will be served, and fifteen (15) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
