This shall serve as notification that, based on the information provided by the Applicant and the staff analysis of that information, and pursuant to M.G.L. c. 111, § 25C and the regulation adopted thereunder, I hereby approve the Request for Minor Change filed by Boston Medical Center (BMC or Holder) in Boston MA. This request for a Minor Change to its previously approved DoN falls within the previously approved Notice of DoN and is reasonable. As proposed, BMC seeks approval for certain renovations which will support the approved closing of the BMC East Newton Campus.

The requested project is approved with an increase in the maximum capital expenditure (MCE) of \$5,799,829, for a total to-date of \$275,495,385 (September 2018 dollars). The proposed change will result in additional community health initiative (CHI) contribution of \$289,991.

This Notice of Final Action incorporates by reference the Staff Report concerning this Application and is subject to the conditions set forth therein and to all prior conditions imposed in previous Notices of DoN related to this project.
