## NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

After a hearing on August 11, 2015, the Commission finds Narnarayan Liquors, Inc. dba Town Line Liquors violated of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (3 counts).

The Commission suspends the licensee's license for a total of five (5) days to be served. The suspension shall commence on Wednesday, September 30, 2015, and terminate on Sunday, October 4, 2015. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, September 30, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Monday, October 5, 2015.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

#### **DECISION**

NARNARAYAN LIQUORS, INC. DBA TOWN LINE LIQUORS 1524 VFW PARKWAY, UNIT A BOSTON, MA 02119 LICENSE#: 011601052

Narnarayan Liquors, Inc. dba Town Line Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol beverage license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 11, 2015, regarding the alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (3 counts). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Teehan's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Techan's Investigative Report dated May 29, 2015;
- Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- Photocopies of Fake Driver's Licenses.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

### **FACTS**

- 1. On Friday, May 29, 2015, at approximately 8:10 p.m., Investigators Carey and Teehan ("Investigators") investigated the business operation of Narnarayan Liquors, Inc. dba Town Line Liquors to determine the manner in which its business was being conducted.
- 2. While outside the licensed premises, at approximately 8:10 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful looking male subject exit the store with a twelve pack of Stella Artois beer, three bottle of Miller High Life beer, and one bottle of pinot grigio wine.
- 3. When Investigators asked the male subject for proof of legal age, the underage male no.1, actual date of birth (age 19), stated that he had used a fake Connecticut Driver's License in his own name with a date of birth (age 19), stated that he had used a fake Connecticut Driver's License in his own name with a date of birth (age 19).

- 4. While still outside the licensed premises, at approximately 8:30 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful looking male subject exit the store with a 30-pack of Miller Light beer and a bottle of Fireball whiskey.
- 5. When Investigators asked the male subject for proof of legal age, underage male no. 2, actual date of birth 01/18/1996 (age 19) stated that he had used a fake Colorado Driver's License in his own name with a date of birth 01/18/1992 to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
- 6. At approximately 8:50 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful looking male subject exit the store with a 12-pack of Redd's apple ale and two cans of Mike's Harder Punch Lemonade premier malt beverage.
- 7. When Investigators asked the male subject for proof of legal age, underage male no. 3, actual date of birth 10/31/1996 (age 18) stated that he had used a fake Connecticut Driver's License in his own name with a date of birth 10/31/1993 to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
- 8. Investigators informed the clerk on duty, Mehu Patel, of the above violations and that a report would be submitted to the Chief Investigator for further action.

#### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (3 counts). Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for fifteen (15) days of which five (5) days will be served and ten (10) days will be held in abevance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
