Onibella, Inc. dba Forest Hill Mart (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 11, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Carey's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Investigator Carey's Compliance Check Field Report dated June 4, 2012.

FACTS

- 1. On Monday, June 4, 2012, at approximately 5:32 p.m., Investigators Carey and Teehan conducted an investigation of the business operation of Onibella, Inc. dba Forest Hill Mart.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-four ounce (24 oz.) container of Bud beer for two dollars and eighty cents (\$2.80). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
