NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

After a hearing on June 10, 2025, the Commission finds Peabody Emarket Inc. d/b/a E Market violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (2 counts).

The Commission **suspends the license for a period of one (1) day to be served.**

The suspension shall be served on Monday, March 30, 2026. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Monday, March 30, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee on Tuesday, March 31, 2026.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 § 23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

DECISION

Peabody Emarket Inc. d/b/a E Market (“Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“Commission” or “ABCC”) held a hearing on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (2 counts). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Di Cicco’s Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigative Report of J. Di Cicco;
2. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Transfer of License Approved 10/14/2022;
3. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.

FINDINGS OF FACT


1. On Friday, February 14, 2025, Special Investigators Smiddy and Di Cicco (“Investigators”) inspected the business operation of Peabody Emarket Inc. d/b/a E Market.
2. At approximately 9:15 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful appearing individual bring multiple bottles of wine to the register for purchase.
3. After the underage individual purchased the wine, Investigators approached him, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to purchase and/or possess alcoholic beverages.
4. Underage #1, actual date of birth 7/28/2004 (age 20), presented to Investigators a fraudulent Vermont driver’s license bearing his name but a different birth date that he used to purchase the alcoholic beverages. Underage #1 was in possession of one 1.75 L bottle of Sutter Home Sweet Peach wine, and one 4-pack of 187 ml bottles of Sutter Home Sweet Red wine.


5. Investigators subsequently observed a youthful appearing female individual purchase a bottle of wine. After the purchase, Investigators approached the female, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to purchase and/or possess alcoholic beverages.
6. Underage #2, actual date of birth 9/08/2004 (age 20), presented to Investigators a fraudulent Rhode Island driver's license bearing her name but a different birth date that she used to purchase the alcoholic beverages. Underage #2 was in possession of one 1 L bottle of Matua wine.
7. Investigators later entered the licensed premises and informed the clerk on duty of the violations, showed the clerk the fraudulent driver's licenses and advised him that a report would be submitted to the Chief Investigator for review.
8. The clerk stated he did sell the alcoholic beverages to these individuals but informed Investigators that he had scanned each identification. He showed Investigators the store's scanning software. Investigators noted that the scanner appeared to just relay the information on the licenses and did not seem to check for discrepancies to determine if the licenses were genuine. Investigators reviewed M.G.L. Ch. 138, §§ 34 and 34B with the clerk.
9. Enas Nashed, Licensee, appeared at the Commission hearing and testified she had taken training courses regarding false identification and trained her staff. In addition, she has ordered a new scanner which provides for software updates.
10. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2022 with no previous violations.


CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (2 Counts). As a result, the Commission **suspends the license for a period of one (1) day.**
