## **DECISION**

TASTES ON THE FLY LOGAN LLC D/B/A STEPHANIE'S LOGAN AIRPORT TERMINAL B **BOSTON, MA 02201** 

LICENSE#: 0116-02044

VIOLATION DATE: 08/08/2017 **HEARING DATE: 2/13/2018** 

Tastes on the Fly Logan LLC d/b/a Stephanie's (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, February 13, 2018, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Di Cicco's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Di Cicco's Compliance Check Field Report; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

## <u>FACTS</u>

- 1. On Tuesday, August 8, 2017, at approximately 5:30 p.m., Investigators Wilichoski and Di Cicco ("Investigators") investigated the business Tastes on the Fly Logan LLC d/b/a Stephanie's.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Bud Light beer, for six dollars and forty-two cents (\$6.42). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for one (1) day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
