After a hearing on April 15, 2014, the Commission finds The Next Place, LLC dba The Greatest Bar in violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §69-Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to an intoxicated person (2 Counts). The Commission **suspends the licensee's license for a total of eight (8) days to be served.**

A request by the licensee to reschedule the suspension for a later date has been allowed by this Commission. The suspension will be divided up into two (2) four (4) day segments

The first suspension period shall commence on **Sunday, February 15, 2015, and terminate on Wednesday, February 18, 2015.** The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Sunday, February 15, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Thursday, February 19, 2015.

The second suspension period shall commence on **Sunday, July 5, 2015 and terminate on Wednesday, July 8, 2015.** The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Sunday, July 5, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Thursday, July 9, 2015.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.
