DECISION

Paradigm, Inc. dba Ye Olde Spirits Shoppe (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c.138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on August 24, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

- 2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

Facts

1. On, June 12, 2010 at approximately 1:46 p.m., Commission Investigators conducted a compliance check on Paradigm, Inc. dba Ye Olde Spirits Shoppe.

2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a 6 pack of Bud Light for \$8.48. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. The Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
