DECISION

HOTEL BOXBOROUGH LESSEE LLC DBA HOLIDAY INN BOXBOROUGH WOODS 242 ADAMS PLACE BOXBOROUGH, MA 01719 LICENSE#: 012200001 HEARD: 10/04/2011

Hotel Boxborough Lessee, LLC dba Holiday Inn Boxborough Woods (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 04, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

FACTS

- 1. On, July 28, 2011 at approximately 12:54 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Hotel Boxborough Lessee, LLC dba Holiday Inn Boxborough Woods.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a bottle of Bud for five dollars and zero cents (\$5.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
