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DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AS OIL BURNER TECHNICIAN

The applicant must demonstrate a thorough knowledge of NFPA 31 and the Oil Burner Code amendments found in 527 CMR 1.00, as well as basic knowledge of oil burners, safety devices, automatic-, electrical- and electronic-controls, and combustion performance testing. Knowledge of pipefitting and heating is essential. The applicant must pass a written examination. Although not required, it is recommended that an applicant for the certificate attend classroom instruction, and obtain an apprentice certificate to learn how to clean boilers and install equipment in a safe and professional manner.

There are no prerequisites for the *apprentice certificate*. The only requirement is that the apprentice work only under the direct supervision of a person holding a valid Massachusetts Certificate of Competency as an Oil Burner Technician.

Applicants must submit the following with a completed application:

- **Applicants must be at least 18 years of age**
- Check or money order payable to Commonwealth of Mass. for the application fee
- A legible color copy of a valid driver's license
- Sign the Authorization for Release of MA RMV Photo on the application. Applicants who do not hold a valid MA driver's license must provide a 1" X 1.25" passport photo
- Application **must** include the applicant's home mailing address and Social Security Number
