Saw-Whet Owl Banding

Join DCR's Office of Natural Resources for a special evening program featuring the Northern Saw-Whet Owl! Each fall these small, secretive owls migrate south from boreal forests of northern North America, passing through Massachusetts from October into November.

DCR biologists have studied and banded these owls for more than a decade. This long-term research helps scientists understand owl migration, population trends, and changing environmental conditions across the northern forests where these birds breed.
