Adults with any type of acquired brain injury (ABI) are invited to explore and consider joining the centers.

The referral process begins with a phone call and a tour, and members can be self-referred or referred by a medical or human services professional.

Transportation to and from your local center may also be available to you.

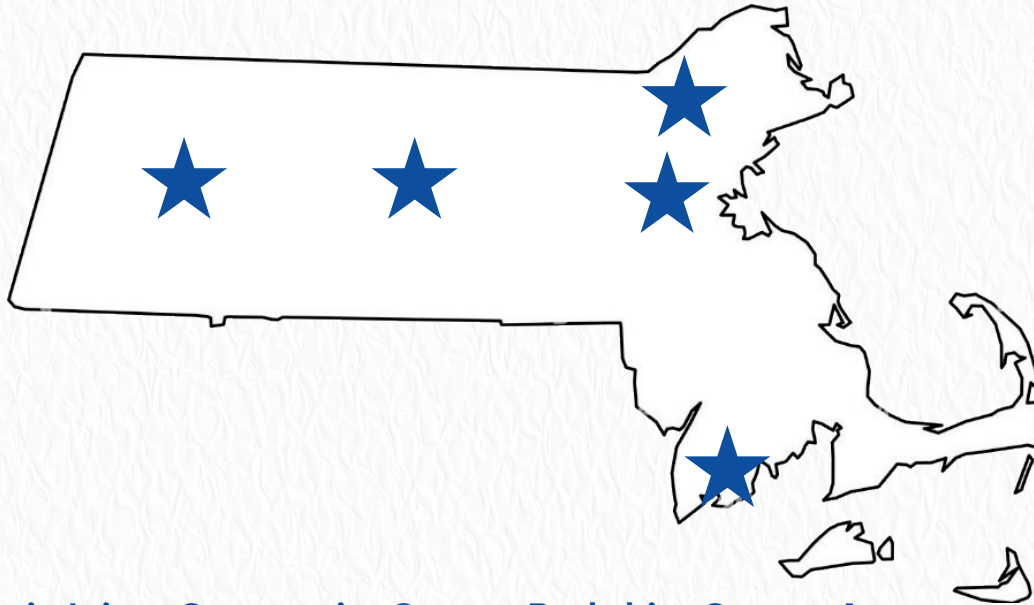
