If a Licensee or Designated Administrator is being inactivated or has had a role change but remains in the Licensee or Designated Administrator role for another program in the umbrella, the Navigator will simply change that submission role to "Employee" Auto update occurs immediately and moves candidate to correct roster tab If consent from is processed and received by the Navigator, no email change will be

When a submission arrives from LEAD for an additional umbrella, the candidate will be provisioned with that email but the correspondence email will remain unchanged.
