DECISION

BREWSTER PIZZA HOUSE, LLC DBA BREWSTER PIZZA HOUSE 2655 MAIN STREET BREWSTER, MA 02631 LICENSE#: 013400024 HEARD: 08/16/2011

Brewster Pizza House, LLC dba Brewster Pizza House (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 16, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

FACTS

- 1. On, May 13, 2011 at approximately 4:09 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Brewster Pizza House, LLC dba Brewster Pizza House.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Bud Light for four dollars (\$4.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file indicates nineteen (19) years of family ownership without a violation.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. The Commission issues a WARNING.
