

# **Project Locus**





# **Overview**



- Replacement of Bridge N-19-059 and Bridge N-19-060 to address structurally deficient and functionally obsolete bridges
- 2700 feet of Route 5 NB & SB improvements, including sidewalks, turning lanes, signals and bicycle lanes.
- Relocation of congested utilities along Route 5 into utility duct banks
- Requesting MassDOT Board approval of \$42.1M contract with J F White Construction Inc
- Work will take 4 years to complete; 2 lanes of traffic in each direction on I-91 will be maintained utilizing temporary bridges

#### **Purpose and Need**





Wood cribbing installed




**Excessive** spalling

- Bridge N-19-059 and Bridge
  N-19-060 are structurally
  deficient and functionally
  obsolete
- Wood cribbing currently installed at Bridge N-19-059 to support deteriorated stringers in span 1 of northbound travel lane
- Stingers at Bridge N-19-059 and N-19-060 have previously gone through repairs in 2011
- Concrete end diaphragms and deck joints are deteriorated

### Purpose and Need (cont'd)





• Congestion on US Route 5 and I-91 at Interchange 18

### Purpose and Need (cont'd)





- Inadequate pedestrian and bicycle accommodations
- Poor travel lanes configuration


- Enhance signalization and add crosswalks at ramp locations to improve vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Update drainage, add curbing, re-align and widen ramps

## **Construction Scope**



#### **Sequence of Construction – I 91 Typical Section**


- Bridges replaced in stages utilizing temporary bridges
- Temporary bridges installed in median to maintain 2 lanes of traffic for I-91 NB and SB.
- NB bridges replaced first followed by SB bridges
- Bridge foundations located on existing foundation footprint to take advantage of existing ground improvements


#### **Sequence of Construction – Route 5**

# Construction Scope (cont'd)





- Construct detention basin along Route 5 and I-91 Ramp
- Construct Floodplain Storage Compensation Area
- Installation of signalized intersections including pedestrian signals and crosswalks.
- Pavement markings and striping including bicycle and dedicated turning lanes

# **Traffic Impacts**



- Two lanes of traffic on I-91 in each direction will be maintained at all times utilizing temporary roadway and bridges in median
- Temporary ramp alignment and reconfiguration
- 45mph speed limit along I-91 during construction
- Nighttime lane closures and short-term detours are available during demolition and erection of steel on US Route 5
- One lane of traffic on US Route 5 in each direction will be maintained at all times during daytime operations

- Environmental Permitting Meetings
  - Meeting on MA WPA NOI January 23, 2020
  - Continuance Meeting on MA WPA NOI April 23, 2020

#### Procurement



- Project was advertised August 1, 2020
- Engineers Estimate was \$47,529,577.00
- Bid Opening was December 8, 2020
- Seven (7) bids were received:
  - J F White Construction Inc
  - ET&L Corp
  - SPS New England Inc
  - Aetna Bridge Company
  - Daniel Oconnells Sons Inc
  - Mohawk Northeast Inc
  - MAB Northampton Constructors LLC
