Andy and Betty Corporation dba Mee King Garden (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 20, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's report.

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
2. Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda; and
3. Photocopy of False Underage Identification Printout.

FACTS


1. On, April 21, 2011 at approximately 10:45 p.m., Commission Investigator Kenny and Binienda investigated the business operation of Andy and Betty Corporation dba Mee King Garden.
2. The investigators entered the premises and observed one (1) youthful looking patron in possession of an alcoholic beverage.
3. The investigators asked the patron for her identification and recorded that she was twenty (20) years of age.
4. She was in possession of a scorpion bowl and stated that no one had asked her for identification.
5. Investigators spoke with the waitress that served the patron and she stated she could not remember if she has asked the patron for identification.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for six (6) days of which six (6) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur**
