#### **Observations and Recommendations**

1. The inmate population was 542 at the time of inspection.

- 2. During the inspection, the CSP found many shower identification tags damaged or painted over and therefore, made them difficult or impossible to read. The CSP recommended implementing a simple numbering system to all toilet and shower stalls to allow the CSP and Correctional staff to better recognize where issues exist.
- 3. At the time of inspection, the CSP observed inmate workers in the kitchen not properly sanitizing food-contact surfaces. It was recommended that kitchen management review and re-train the appropriate cleaning and sanitizing protocols with kitchen staff and inmate workers.

This facility does not comply with the Department's Regulations cited above.
