# Dear Sheriff Hodgson:

In accordance with M.G.L. c. 111, §§ 5, 20, and 21, as well as Massachusetts Department of Public Health (Department) Regulations 105 CMR 451.000: Minimum Health and Sanitation Standards and Inspection Procedures for Correctional Facilities; 105 CMR 480.000: Storage and Disposal of Infectious or Physically Dangerous Medical or Biological Waste (State Sanitary Code, Chapter VIII); 105 CMR 590.000: Minimum Sanitation Standards for Food Establishments (State Sanitary Code Chapter X); the 2013 Food Code; 105 CMR 500.000 Good Manufacturing Practices for Food; and 105 CMR 205.000 Minimum Standards Governing Medical Records and the Conduct of Physical Examinations in Correctional Facilities; the Department's Community Sanitation Program (CSP) conducted an inspection of the Bristol County Jail, Ash Street Facility on May 30, 2019 accompanied by Lieutenant Andrew Mitzan, Environmental Health and Safety Officer and Captain Antonio Oliveira. # **Observations and Recommendations**

- 1. The Inmate population was 170 at the time of inspection.
- 2. At the time of inspection:
  - a. Inmates were showering in both the Day Room and on some of the tiers. The CSP recommends all showers be cleaned daily and kept in good repair per 105 CMR 451.123;
  - b. At the time of inspection, the kitchen was not fully in use. All food is prepared and transferred daily from the Bristol County Jail & House of Correction;
  - c. The warewash machine was not functioning properly. The CSP was informed everything is pre-washed at this facility, then once it returns to the House of Correction, all items are put through the mechanical warewash machine to be washed and sanitized. If there are any items that need to be used at this facility, the CSP recommended using the 3-compartment sink to ensure sanitization;
  - d. The walk-in milk cooler was removed from the kitchen; and
  - e. The CSP recommended installing soap holders on the wall in the Day Room showers so inmates do not have to keep soap on the floor.

This facility does not comply with the Department's Regulations cited above. In accordance with 105 CMR 451.404, please submit a plan of correction within 10 working days of receipt of this notice, indicating the specific corrective steps to be taken, a timetable for such steps, and the date by which correction will be achieved. The plan should be signed by the Superintendent or Administrator and submitted to my attention, at the address listed above.
