**N & H LIQUOR INC. D/B/A SWEENEY'S DISCOUNT LIQUORS

N & H Liquor Inc. d/b/a Sweeney's Discount Liquors ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138 § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 Count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Velez's report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigative Report of N. Velez;
2. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Transfer of License Approved 11/22/2022;
3. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On Thursday, April 9, 2026, Investigators McDonough and Velez ("Investigators") inspected the business operation of N & H Liquor Inc. d/b/a Sweeney's Discount Liquors ("Licensee").
2. At approximately 8:57 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful appearing male individual who appeared under 21-years of age, enter the licensed premises. Minutes later, this same male exited the establishment in possession of a black plastic bag which appeared to contain alcoholic beverages.
3. Investigators identified themselves to the male and requested proof of legal age to purchase and/or possess alcoholic beverages.

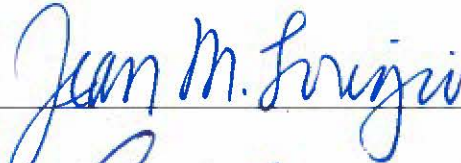
4. Underage #1, actual date of birth 09/24/2006 (age 19), was in possession of two 750 ML bottles of Smirnoff Red, White & Berry vodka. Underage #1 stated to Investigators that he was not asked for any identification when he purchased the alcoholic beverages.
5. At approximately 9:12 p.m., Investigators entered the licensed premises and identified themselves to the clerk on duty, informed him of the above violation and that a report would be submitted to the Chief Investigator for further review.
6. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2022.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138 § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 Count). As a result, the Commission **SUSPENDS the license for a period of 1 day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.**

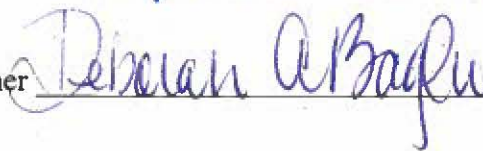
