August 11, 2021 Meeting Minutes

General notes on format of these minutes

Regular Meeting Portion

1. Minutes. On a MOTION by Dana Haagensen, seconded by Doug Anderson, it was a unanimous vote to approve the draft meeting minutes for July 28, 2021, Existing Buildings Code Technical Advisory Committee (EAC) as amended (**EXHIBIT B**). Mike Tusino and Doug Anderson abstained. Dana Haagensen offered clarification on item number 2 to the last sentence. He recalled Chairman DiMascio did not have an issue with committee members looking through Chapter 33 in the 2021 IBC as part of considering a change to the 2021 IEBC Chapter 15 that would send the reader to the IBC Chapter 33.
2. Chairman DiMascio decided to table the IEBC Chapter 13 (**EXHIBIT C**), for more information to be presented by Dana Haagensen. Chairman DiMascio asked for Dana Haagensen's information to be blended into this



Chapter. Dana Haagensen indicated he would no longer have interest in offering his changes if changes being developed by Chairman DiMascio were to be adopted.

The group has a general discussion on the Mass amendment to Section 1301.1.2 Compliance Alternatives Notification, known as a Mass amendment to the IEBC Section 1401.1.2 in the 9th. No decisions about this section were made.

Next, the group discussed Chapter 15 (**EXHIBIT D**). Jacob Nunnemacher talked about a document he created that compares the 2021 IBC Chapter 33 to the 2021 IEBC Chapter 15. He believes the requirements are about the same. For this reason, he recommends amending Chapter 15 to Chapter 33 in the 2021 IEBC. The group discussed its task is to review the IEBC and provide recommendations to the BBRS on the 2021 IEBC, and this charge does not include making recommendations on Chapter 33 in the 2021 IBC.

On a **MOTION** by Doug Anderson, seconded by Vernon Woodworth, it was a unanimous vote to delete Chapter 15 in the 2021 IEBC and replace it with; shall comply with Chapter 33 of the International Building Code. Michael Shearer abstained.

3. Under the matters not reasonably anticipated 48 hours in advance of the meeting agenda item, Doug Anderson spoke about NFPA-101 reference was not removed from IEBC Section 805.2 in the 9th Edition but was removed from the 8th Edition. Chairman DiMascio talked about the BBRS tasks include amending the national codes as little as possible reason.
4. Adjourn Session. On a **MOTION** by, Jacob Nunnemacher seconded by Barry Gehorn, it was unanimously **VOTED** by ROLL CALL to adjourn the meeting @ approximately 11:15 a.m.
