On June 8, 2015, the U.S. Department of Education (DOE) announced a series of [steps to support students who attended Corinthian schools](#). For some students, this may include forgiveness of their federal student loan debt.

According to this announcement, you may be eligible for federal student loan forgiveness if you are in one of two situations:

- (1) you attended a Corinthian school that closed on April 27, 2015; or
- (2) you believe you were defrauded by the Corinthian school you attended or that the school otherwise engaged in actions that violated applicable state law—regardless of whether that school closed.
