Earn a degree in Early Childhood Development

The program is a two-year associate degree program where learners earn their Early Childhood Development degree while working in the field. Full-time “learn as you earn model”. Apprentices receive:

- Structured on-the-job training under a mentor.
- Related technical instruction to complement training.
- Progressive wage increases for skills and competencies gained.

Apprentices completing an A.S. in Early Childhood Development qualify to be Lead Teacher Certified by Massachusetts Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) standards.

Program Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Must be willing to work in the City of Boston
- Must be eligible for work in the US

Previous experience is not required but is preferred.
