PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Staff Summary is to request that the Board of Directors authorize and approve the Secretary/CEO, or their designee, to execute MassDOT Contract No. 129715 titled Burlington to Tyngsborough - Pavement Preservation on Route 3, for Highway Construction, with HOLCIM-NER Inc, for the amount of \$17,676,110.60, for a total duration, not to exceed, 773 days from Notice to Proceed (NTP).

TOTAL PROGRAM BUDGET:

The project has a total program budget of \$20,617,998.40, which includes the following:

DISCUSSION:

The award of Contract No. 129715 titled Burlington to Tyngsborough - Pavement Preservation on Route 3 will address immediate needs to replace the deteriorated pavement, as well as reducing ongoing maintenance costs for District 4 in this area of Route 3.

The work to be done consists primarily of milling and resurfacing the existing Route 3 mainline, the Exit 72B SB off-ramp, and bridges within the project limits.

Additional work consists of removing and disposing of substandard guardrail end treatments and replacement with MASH-compliant w-beam guardrail end treatments; adjusting and cleaning drainage structures; replacing damaged or non-lockdown frames, covers, and grates; upgrading ITS and TDC equipment; placement of new pavement markings; tree trimming; and incidental work as required by the Engineer.

PROCUREMENT:

On March 15, 2025, the Highway Division advertised this contract for bids. On May 13, 2025, the Highway Division opened bids for this contract and five (5) bids were received. HOLCIM-NER Inc was the lowest responsible and eligible bidder with a bid price of \$17,676,110.60.

The bids were reviewed by engineers in the Construction and Specifications Sections. The Highway Division has accepted the bid submitted by HOLCIM-NER Inc, which at \$17,676,110.60 is 15.86% less than the Office Estimate of \$21,007,095.00.

MassDOT's Office for Diversity and Civil Rights has reviewed the DBE information included in the Proposal of the chosen bidder and recommends award of the DBB Contract to this team.

FINANCIAL IMPACT/BUDGET SOURCE:

This action is funded through the National Highway Performance Program – National Highway System (NHS) program, which is 80% Federal Aid and the National Highway Performance Program – On-System Bridge (BRR-ON) program, which is 80% Federal Aid. All funding necessary for the construction of the project is provided in the FY2025 – FY2029 MassDOT Capital Investment Plan. There will be no potential projects placed at risk with the approval of this request by the MassDOT Board of Directors.
