TO: ALL INSURANCE COMPANIES, ALL SELF-INSURERS, AND
WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION AGENTS OF DEPARTMENTS OF THE
COMMONWEALTH AND COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS
SUBJECT TO THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW (GENERAL
LAWS, CHAPTER 152, AS AMENDED)

Gentlemen:

Your attention is directed to the provisions of
Chapter 665 of the Acts of 1958.

The maximum rate of compensation for injuries which
occur on or after January 15, 1959 is \$40 a week, beginning
with the first week of incapacity.

This maximum weekly rate applies to compensation payable
under sections 34, 34A and 35.
