CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 127

TO: ALL INSURANCE COMPANIES, ALL SELF-INSURERS, AND WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION AGENTS OF DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS SUBJECT TO THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW (GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 152, AS AMENDED).

IN RE: CHARGES OF HOSPITALS FOR SERVICES UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Enclosed herewith is a list of hospitals, together with their respective per diem rates as approved by the Industrial Accident Board with relation to their charges for the above-captioned services.

These rates are effective as of July 1, 1962, and shall continue in effect until July 1, 1963.

It is to be noted that the per diem rate for Federal Hospitals is \$23.00. This is not an all-inclusive rate, and certain charges such as laboratory, x-ray, transfusions, etc., will be billed in addition.
