CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 14

Dear Sir:

I have been directed by the Industrial Accident Board to ask if you would be so kind as to post this communication conspicuously where it will come to the attention of parties to industrial accident proceedings held in your building from time to time and serve as notice to them of the following vote of the Board passed on January 19, 1939.

"VOTED, all requests for findings of fact or rulings of law must be filed in writing with the single member not later than completion of all the evidence, unless in the discretion of the member a longer period is allowed."

"No such requests will be received by a reviewing board for the first time. "

Requests for findings of fact and rulings of law must be filed separately and must be backed appropriately. Each separate request must be numbered.
