CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 155

TO: ALL INSURANCE COMPANIES, ALL SELF-INSURERS, AND WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION AGENTS OF DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS SUBJECT TO THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW (GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 152, AS AMENDED).

Your attention is invited to the provisions of Chapter 482 of the Acts of 1967, a copy of which is enclosed.

Effective November 12, 1967 the maximum weekly benefits payable under Sections 34, 34A and 35 have been increased to sixty-two (\$62.00) a week.

This new rate, of course, applies only to injuries which occur in the period between November 12, 1967 and October 13, 1968.
