CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 2

TO: ALL INSURERS, COMPENSATION AGENTS UNDER GENERAL
LAWS, CHAPTER 152, Section 75, and HOSPITALS.

The following vote and rule of the Industrial
Accident Board is published for the information and
guidance of all concerned:

VOTED: Effective November 22, 1934, that
fees for special nurses may be
allowed in the discretion of the
Board where the necessity for such
service is found to exist and where
such service is furnished upon the
order or recommendation of the
attending physician and that, where
the services of one such nurse is
found necessary, the fee of not
exceeding \$35.00 a week may be
allowed. Where the services of more
than one such nurse are found to be
necessary, fees not exceeding \$70.00
a week, irrespective of the number of
nurses employed in such case, may be
allowed in the discretion of the Board.

The foregoing rule does not affect the previous
rule that no allowance will be made for "board" of nurses
in such cases.
