CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 22

To: ALL INSURERS

Re: NOTICE TO DEPARTMENT  
OF RESUMPTION OF  
COMPENSATION PAYMENTS

In certain cases where compensation has been paid by agreement or decision and compensation payments discontinued correctly, the insurer resumes the payment of compensation to the employee.

In all such cases, the insurer shall file with the Department form number Mass. I.A.B. No. 25 entitled "Notice to Department of Industrial Accidents of the Resumption of Compensation Payments."

Copy of form number Mass. I.A.B. No. 25 is page two of this letter.

The paper used by insurers in printing form number Mass. I.A.B. No. 25 must approximate in color the paper on which page two of this letter is written.

Insurers are enjoined to comply strictly with this order.
