CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 24

TO: ALL INSURERS

RE: VALUE OF MEALS AS
COMPONENT OF AVERAGE
WEEKLY WAGES UNDER
G.L.(T.E.) Chapter 152,
section 1-(1)

The Industrial Accident Board has voted that, effective October 1, 1940, the value of meals furnished as part of the wages to restaurant employees shall, for the purpose of determining their value as a component of the average weekly wages under General Laws, (T.E.), chapter 152, section 1 -(1), be fixed as twenty-five cents (25¢) a meal.
