CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 27

To: ALL INSURERS

RE: VALUE OF MEALS AND LODGING  
AS COMPONENT OF AVERAGE  
WEEKLY WAGES UNDER G. L.  
(T.E.) Chapter 152, section  
1-(1)

The Industrial Accident Board voted on April 17, 1941 to extend the application of the provisions of circular letters numbered 23, 24 and 26, relative to the value of meals and lodging as components of "average weekly wages" under General Laws (T.E.), Chapter 152, section 1, clause 1, so as to include with hotel employees and employees of commercial restaurants all other employees receiving meals and/or lodging as part of wages, but not including public employees under the provisions of General Laws (T.E.), Chapter 152, section 69.
