CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 28

To: ALL INSURERS

RE: ESTABLISHING TENTATIVE
RATE FOR HOSPITAL WARD
CARE

The Industrial Accident Board in the exercise of its discretion under General Laws (Ter. Ed.), Chapter 152, section 30, as amended, approve a maximum of twenty-eight dollars (\$28.00) a week, as reasonable for hospital board and room (ward), where such services are necessary, such rate to be in effect for a period of six months from July 1, 1941 to December 31, 1941, applicable only to injuries occurring during such period, and inapplicable to hospitals in which the rate charged to the general public is less than the rate herein approved.
