CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 29

TO: ALL INSURERS

RE: RATE FOR HOSPITAL WARD CARE

Circular letter no. 28, dated July 1, 1941, issued to all insurers relative to "Establishing Tentative Rate for Hospital Ward Care" is rescinded.

The Industrial Accident Board, in the exercise of its discretion under General Laws (Ter. Ed.), Chapter 152, Section 30, as amended, approve the maximum of twenty-eight dollars (\$28.00) a week as reasonable for hospital board and room (ward) where such services are necessary, this rate to be in effect from January 1, 1942 until further notice.

This rate is applicable to such services furnished subsequent to January 1, 1942.
