CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 31

To: All Insurers

RE: I. A. B. #1:
NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES

General Laws, (Ter. Ed.), Chapter 152, Sections 21, 22 and 30, and amendments thereto, require every insured person to give written or printed notice to all persons under contract of hire with him and to every person with whom he is about to enter into a contract of hire, that he has provided for payment to injured employees by the insurer under Chapter 152 in the manner therein provided, or in such other manner as may be approved by the Department.

Under the provisions of these Sections, the Department prescribes I. A. B. #1 entitled "Notice To Employees" in the form set forth on page 58 of the 1942 edition of General Laws, (Ter. Ed.), Chapter 152. A copy of this publication has been furnished each insurer, or may be had upon written request. No other form may be used by any insured person after November 30, 1942, and insurer are required to furnish each subscriber to the provisions of the Act insured by the insurer with the necessary notices for proper posting.

Insurers are enjoined to comply strictly with this order. Each insurer is required to acknowledge receipt of this circular letter, addressing the reply to the Insurance Register.
