Mileage Reimbursement Rate for Workers' Compensation

Upon consideration of the increase in the cost of travel in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, it is determined that an increase is warranted for the per mile reimbursement rate paid to injured workers for travel to and from medical treatment and for travel to and from vocational training and/or education under an approved Individual Written Rehabilitation Plan.

Effective May 15, 2022, the travel reimbursement rate will be 58.5 cents per mile.
