
To: ALL INSURERS AND
SELF INSURERS

RE: MANNER OF PAYMENT
OF COMPENSATION

The attention of all insurers and self insurers is directed to the long standing rule of the Board that insurance companies (also now self insurers) are required to mail or deliver the compensation due under the Workmen's Compensation Act to the homes of employees entitled thereto, except in cases where employees waive their rights to so receive compensation and agree or express a desire to receive same at the office or branch office of the insurer, or self insurer.

All insurers and self insurers will be held to strict account in the observance of this rule.
