RE: CHARGES APPROVED FOR
MEDICAL SERVICES IN
CERTAIN CASES

Circular Letter #40 in reference to charges approved for medical services in certain cases dated March 23, 1945, is corrected with reference to the item entitled "BLUE CROSS" by the substitution of the word - semi-private - for the word "private," so that this item will read as follows:

BLUE CROSS

The Blue Cross agreed to pay the difference in cost between industrial ward rates in compensation cases and the rate of semi-private rooms when selected by an employee who is a member of the Blue Cross.
