CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 69

TO: ALL HOSPITALS

IN RE: CHARGES OF HOSPITALS FOR SERVICES UNDER THE  
WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the procedure followed in the past two years the Department of Public Health furnished each hospital with the necessary blanks so that its Statement of Reimbursable Cost would be filed before May 1, 1951 in order that the rate for each hospital for industrial accident cases could be determined and approved by the Industrial Accident Board. To date some of these Statements have not been filed.

Hospitals are requested to kindly file Statements immediately with the Department of Public Health.

Hospitals are advised that the new approved rates to be paid in industrial accident cases will be effective as of July 1, 1951, and remain in effect to July 1, 1952.

Any hospital which fails to submit a Statement immediately shall have its rate determined by the Industrial Accident Board, and such rate will not be subject to change after July 1, 1951.
