RATE FOR SPECIAL DUTY NURSES IN WORKMEN'S COMPENSA- TION CASES

The Industrial Accident Board have voted that effective October 22, 1951, the per diem rate of compensation for special duty nurses in attendance on workmen's compensation cases will be approved at not to exceed \$11 for each day of 8 hour duty; \$16.50 per day of 12 hour duty and \$17.50 per day of 20 hour duty.

No additional allowance is made for board of such special nurses.
