
CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 84

TO: ALL INSURERS, SELF-INSURERS, AND TO ALL PUBLIC UNITS  
SUBJECT TO GENERAL LAWS (TER. ED.) CHAPTER 152, SECTIONS  
60 to 75 INCLUSIVE.

The Industrial Accident Board have voted that effective May 1, 1953, the per diem rate of compensation for special duty nurses in attendance on workmen's compensation cases will be approved at not to exceed \$11.50 per eight hour period from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.; \$12.00 per eight hour period from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.; \$17.25 per twelve hour duty; and \$18.25 per twenty hour duty.

No additional allowance is made for board of such special nurses.
