Ajit Nambiar dba 7 Eleven (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 11, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34-Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator's Teehan's report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Teehan's Report dated March 6, 2013; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On Wednesday, March 6, 2013, at approximately 5:48 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Teehan investigated the licensed premises of Ajit Nambiar dba 7 Eleven to determine the manner in which their business was being conducted.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators was in possession of an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-four ounce (24 oz.) can of Budweiser beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

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## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34-Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
