Ajit Nambiar d/b/a 7-Eleven (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 6, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)-Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Kenny's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Kenny's Compliance Check Field Report;
- 2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact;
- 3. ABCC Decision, 6/11/2013; and
- 4. Licensee's License Application.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, April 3, 2019, at approximately 5:48 p.m., Investigators Teehan and Kenny ("Investigators") investigated the business of Ajit Nambiar d/b/a 7-Eleven.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Bud Light beer, for eight dollars and fifty-nine cents (\$8.59). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee has been licensed under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2011.

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)-Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21). Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
