DECISION

TEDESCHI FOOD SHOPS, INC. DBA CROWELL'S MARKET
2160 WASHINGTON ST.

Tedeschi Food Shops, Inc. dba Crowell's Market (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 7, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kenny's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Investigator Kenny's Compliance Check Field Report dated March 6, 2013.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS


1. On Wednesday, March 6, 2013, at approximately 5:25 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Teehan conducted an investigation of the business operation of Tedeschi Food Shops, Inc. dba Crowell's.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-four ounce (24 oz.) can of Budweiser beer, for two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.


CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for twenty (20) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
