**NEW COBB CORNER LIQUOR INC. D/B/A CANTON VILLAGE WINE & SPIRITS

New Cobb Corner Liquor Inc. d/b/a Canton Village Wine & Spirits (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 10, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Kenny's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Kenny's Compliance Check Field Report;
2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact; and
3. Copy of Licensee's License Application Approved 9/17/2015.

FACTS


1. On Wednesday, April 3, 2019, at approximately 5:44 p.m., Investigators Teehan and Kenny ("Investigators") investigated the business of New Cobb Corner Liquor Inc. d/b/a Canton Village Wine & Spirits.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee alcoholic beverages, a can of Bud Light beer for two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2015 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21). The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
