DECISION

TRI TOWN DISCOUNT LIQUORS, LLC
100A WASHINGTON STREET
CANTON, MA 02021

Tri Town Discount Liquors, LLC (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 7, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Teehan's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report dated March 6, 2013; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS


1. On Wednesday, March 6, 2013, at approximately 6:14 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Teehan conducted an investigation of the business operation of Tri Town Discount Liquors, LLC.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-four ounce (24 oz.) container of Bud Light beer, for two dollars and fifty-five cents (\$2.55). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**


