<b>Process Utilized to correct and review indicator</b>	Status at follow-up During the period of 2/1/25 - 4/15/25, 12 individuals in Employment and Day Supports had ISP assessments due. Out of those 12, two were requested late by the Service Coordinator. Four of the remaining assessments were submitted outside of the required timelines.

<b>Indicator</b>	Assistive technology
<b>Area Need Improvement</b>	For nine individuals, assistive technology assessments were not completed, or recommendations were not followed up on. The agency needs to ensure individuals have access to assistive technology to maximize their independence.
<b>Process Utilized to correct and review indicator</b>	While the Employment program has made significant progress in completing assessments and providing designated follow-up, Day Supports continues to face challenges with the "follow-through" on AT assessments. Although all assessments have been completed, further attention is required to ensure the acquisition of the technology and the evaluation of its effectiveness. The Day Supports program leadership has very recently begun exploring the creation of a device for persons served to use at the Cape Abilities Farm during planting season to assist individuals with accurately placing seeds.
