

# MassDOT and FMCB Vote \$60M in Capital Support for MBTA

- The MBTA’s Capital Maintenance Lockbox Fund is used to fund a wide range of capital improvement projects, many focusing on shorter-term, customer-facing initiatives. These funds provide critical capital dollars for projects related to facilities, T station improvements, technology upgrades as well as track, signal systems and power supply that allow the subway cars to operate.
- Lockbox Fund has funded \$637.9 million in capital investments since it was created by the Board in 2016. Of the total, the Commonwealth has funded \$257.9 million.
- Asking the DOT board to approve the FY21 \$60 million in capital support for the MBTA which would bring the total Commonwealth support up to \$317.9 million.
