- ☐ Flashlight

Seasonal Items

Winter weather can be dangerous for drivers in Massachusetts. Consider carrying the following items during winter months:

- ☐ Small Shovel
- ☐ Blanket

Make sure the safety kit is accessible from inside of the vehicle. Consider placing the **kit under the passenger seat** for easy access.

Stay Safe. Be Seen.

In roadside situations, always assess your surroundings. Your safety is important. These steps and items will help you **stay visible** as you call for help or should you need to exit your vehicle.

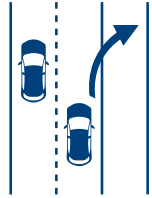
Steps to take in Roadside Emergencies

Every roadside emergency is unique, be vigilant and prioritize your safety. Follow these recommended safety steps only when safe to do so.

On a roadway with a right-hand shoulder, pull over as far as possible. Stay inside and avoid standing near traffic.

Park your vehicle. Turn on your hazard lights. At night, turn on interior lights.

Find your location with GPS and call for help.



In case you must exit your vehicle

Put on your safety vest inside the vehicle. Assess the situation before exiting on the side away from traffic. Raise the vehicle's hood.

Place your safety triangles or LED flares at 10 feet and 100 feet behind the vehicle. Make sure you walk as far away from traffic as is safely possible.
