# DECISION

## TULENO INC. D/B/A FIESTA CHARRA 66 MAIN STREET, #2 CARVER, MA 02330 LICENSE#: 04403-RS-0174 VIOLATION DATE: 3/11/2024 HEARD: 4/30/2024

Tuleno Inc. d/b/a Fiesta Charra ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, April 30, 2024, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Kenny & Terasconi's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigators Kenny & Terasconi's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report, 3/11/2024;
- 2. ABCC Local Licensing Authority Review, New License;
- 3. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. On Monday, March 11, 2024, at approximately 5:33 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Terasconi ("Investigators") conducted a compliance check at Tuleno Inc. d/b/a Fiesta Charra.
- 2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, one bottle of Bud Light beer, for six dollars and sixty-four cents (\$6.64). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee holds a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 with no prior violations.

#### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING.**
